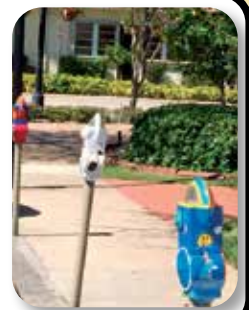

- Approved Ordinance on First Reading, adopting the 2021 capital improvements project schedule annual update to the Miami Shores Village 2025 Comprehensive Plan.
- Approved Resolution, extending the sunset date of Resolution 2020-10 for the temporary moratorium on enforcement of outdoor cafes due to COVID-19.
- Directed the Village Manager to gather additional information regarding the proposed recommendations relative to the installation of walking paths throughout the Village and for the findings to be brought forth for Council consideration.
