

MAY 2021 HISTORIC HOUSE OF THE MONTH





The Miami Shores Village house of the month was built in 1926, the house was designed by Kiehnel & Elliott one of the firms that helped establish the Mediterranean Revival theme and character of the original Miami Shores development. Renderings of this home were used in advertising by the ShorelandCompanytopromotetheMiamiShoresproject. Theresidence is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and was designated locally in 1983.



BUILDING DEPARTMENT CORNER

At the Miami Shores Village Building Department, we strive to provide each of you with the best service! Your safety is our number one priority. Our department is a regulatory agency that is mandated by Federal, State, and Local regulations, enacted through a legislative process to protect the health, safety, and welfare of those who live, work, and play within our community.

Working together we can help each other achieve our goals to keep our community safe and enjoyable. Please make us part of your team, we are here to help. Below please find a link to our electronic permitting system, Citizen Self Service (CSS). In addition, We have provided a "How to Apply for a Permit Online Tutorial" YouTube video that can assist you in successfully submitting a permit online via our CSS system.

Once you access the CSS, we highly recommend that you go to "FORMS", where you will find the permit applications, permit requirements, affidavits, and supporting documents, in addition to contact information for outside agencies. All projects, regardless of size, will require a permit application along with supporting documents. Permit applications are required to be properly filled out, and shall include the notarized signature of the owner, owner's agent and contractor. Supporting documents, such as plans and calculations, shall be signed and sealed by a Florida licensed design professional. You may access the Florida Building Code at https://floridabuilding.org.

IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS CURRENTLY HAPPENING IN MIAMI SHORES



The Accessible Street Parking Project will be addressing ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) concerns at several locations on existing on-street parking areas adjacent to the Village's Downtown corridor (along NE 2nd Avenue). Work is scheduled to last 2-3 months, weatherpermitting. The project will include Milling and Resurfacing, minimal reconstruction, pavement markings and update signage in order to achieve ADA requirements. The NE 2nd AVE Multimodal Improvement Project has begun and is scheduled to be completed by Summer 2021, weather permitting! The scope of work includes widening of sidewalks along NE 2nd AVE between NE 111 ST to NE 103 ST as well as ADA improvements made to sidewalks at the crossings of existing driveways, alleyways and at the 111 ST intersection! The Brockway Memorial Library expansion continues! The expansion will add a 1200 sq. ft. performance and program room, a family restroom, storage space and an office for the Youth Services Librarian. Funding for this project came from many generous donations from our beloved residents and friends amounting to nearly \$300,000 and supplemented by a \$350,000 allocation from the Miami Shores Village Council in June of 2016, as well as a grant from the Miami Shores Community Alliance.

Code Compliance Corner

HELP US HELP YOU..IT IS A REQUIREMENT IN THE VILLAGE TO BAG YOUR LEAVES

Grass cuttings and leaves from shrubbery and trees shall be placed in containers with a minimum capacity of 20 gallons and a maximum capacity of 40 gallons. Containers shall be of galvanized metal, durable plastic or plastic bags.

We will be conducting inspections of alleys throughout the Village. During these inspections, we will be focusing on making sure residents are bagging their leaves. The bagging of leaves assist greatly in expediting sanitation services throughout the Village and with overall aesthetics of the area. Help us continue making #theVillageBeautiful!


