
## Adult Programs

### CODE COMPLIANCE CORNER

Living in Miami Shores is paradise, but along with fun in the sun, we also have a RAINY SEASON. The constant rains, along with our lush trees, are sometimes to blame for the stained or dirty exterior surfaces roof, walls, planters, driveway, etc. The Administration in Miami Shores is in tune with its residents and understands that during the rainy season, it is not an easy time to clean your roof. Towards the end of the rainy season, we pick up the frequency of inspections for dirty exterior surfaces. This period allows homeowners to coordinate cleaning, repairing, and/or painting activities without having to worry about rainy days. We encourage



residents to inspect the exterior surfaces of their home for any signs of damage, staining, dead vegetation, peeling, spalling, or weathered exterior surfaces. These factors contribute to the decline of the overall appearance of a home and when coupled with multiple residences, it does affect the value of our beautiful community. Please see below for the section of our code that outlines the requirement to keep the exterior surfaces of your property clean and maintained.

#### Sec. 12-133. - Depreciation of surrounding property.

The exterior of every structure shall be so maintained with reasonable attractiveness so as not, in the case of excessive scaling of paint or excessive mildew, to cause a substantial depreciation in property values in the immediate neighborhood. The exterior surfaces shall be kept free from materials, objects, and conditions, which will have an adverse effect on adjacent premises.


## Recreation Department
