To Prospective Proposers:

This Addendum No. 1 to the above-referenced Request for Proposals (“RFP”) is issued in response to questions from prospective bidders, or other clarifications and revisions issued by the Village. The RFP is amended in the following particulars only.

1. *Will the Village consider waiving the Performance and Payment bond Requirement as the Federal procurement regulations in 2 CFR §200.325 only recommends bonding requirements for construction or facility improvements contracts.*

Response: Yes, the requirement has been waived. The Village will not require a Payment and Performance Bond if the contract is called upon due to a debris generating disaster.

2. Will the Village consider waiving the liquidated damages provision included on page 23 of the RFP.

Response: No. Should the awarded contractor fail to mobilize or complete work on schedule then liquidated damages may occur. The Village wishes to be protected financially if FEMA reimbursement is jeopardized by such delays.
