### **Miami Shores Village Inventory of Communitywide Greenhouse Gas Emissions Report**

March 24, 2023

Miami Shores Village is releasing its first Inventory of Communitywide Greenhouse Gas Emissions Report. The Village was selected by the Florida League of Cities to receive a scholarship and be part of the Florida Race to Zero Cohort. The scholarship provides access to structured and technical assistance through ICLEI (International Council for Local Environmental Initiatives). The findings from the science-based methodology will be used as the baseline to develop a Plan-of-Action to achieve reduction of greenhouse gas emissions by a target year.

During the Village Council meeting of March 21, 2023, staff presented the findings of the report. The Inventory report was positively received by the community. Resident Ms. Mary Benton mentioned during the meeting that “what we are doing in this Village could not have come at a more important time.”
